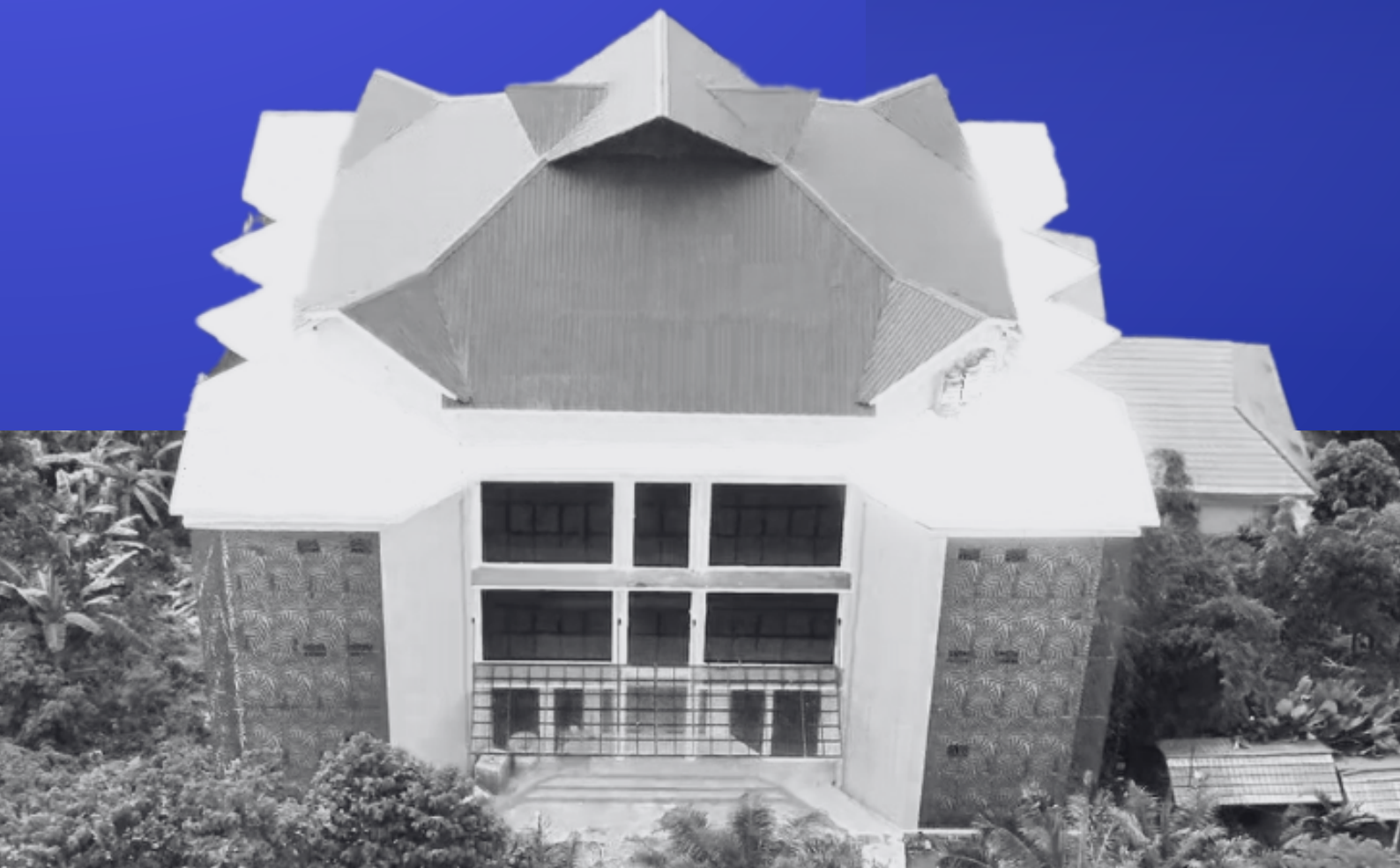

SECRET RIVER DOLPHIN IN MAHAKAM RIVER

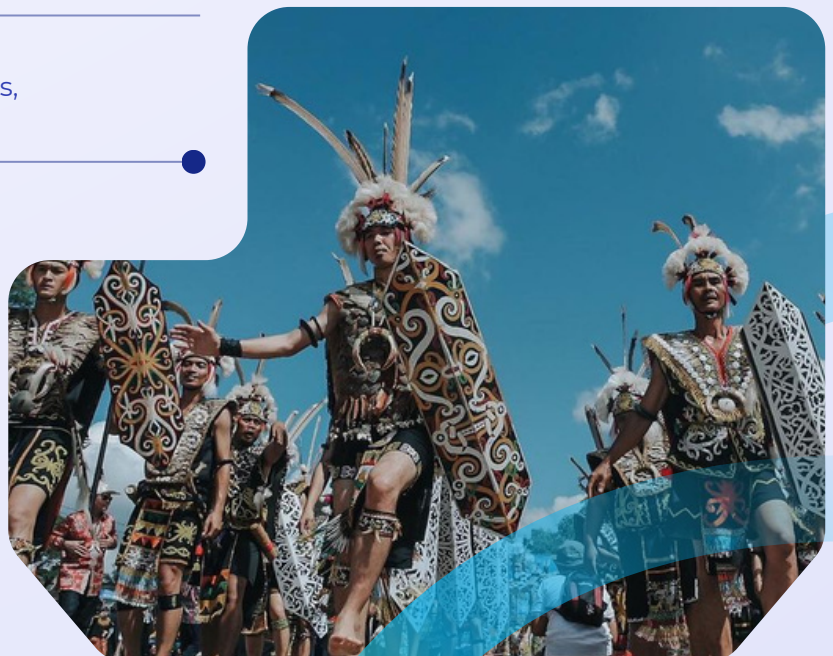

Inbound Student's Research Stay Program

Eligibility:

- Active undergraduate (minimum on 3rd year), Postgraduate (Minimum 1st year) students.
 - TOEFL PBT 500 / IELTS 5.5 or equivalent.
 - Minimum GPA of 3.00/4.00.
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Required Documents:

- Letter of recommendation from supervisor (English).
 - Proof of enrollment as an active student (English).
 - English proficiency test score.
 - Latest academic transcript (English).
 - Valid passport copy (min. 2 years validity) and Student ID.
 - Health certificate.
 - Letter of declaration.

- Round-trip transportation for students from their home country to Indonesia.
 - Accommodation costs during the research period in Indonesia (1 to 6 months).
 - Obtain the opportunity to publish research findings in reputable scientific journals.
 - Research funding from selected supervisor.

Full-Degree Program

Eligibility:

- International applicants for Undergraduate, Master's, or Doctoral degree programs.
 - Completion of previous academic qualifications relevant to the intended degree level.
 - Minimum school report grade 75/100 (undergraduate) or academic GPA of 3.00/4.00 or equivalent (postgraduate).
 - Bahasa Indonesia proficiency for daily and academic communication.
 - TOEFL PBT 500 / IELTS 5.5 or equivalent.

- Academic certificates and official academic transcripts (English).
 - Letter of motivation / Statement of Purpose.
 - English proficiency test score.
 - Valid passport copy (min. 2 years validity) and Student ID.
 - Student visa and immigration documents (upon acceptance).

 - Letter of Declaration.
