We have carefully conducted the selection process, considering several aspects such as English language proficiency, communication skills, knowledge of the beef industry in Indonesia-Australia, and the implementation of biosecurity measures. From the nine university locations we visited, we are delighted to witness the exceptional knowledge and insight that Indonesian students possess regarding the beef industry, along with their ambitious aspirations for the development of beef cattle farming in Indonesia.

It is with great pleasure that we announce the selection of 20 Indonesian students who have been granted the opportunity to participate in the NTI 360 program in Australia. We sincerely hope that the chosen students will receive wholehearted support from your faculty and university, enabling them to share their experiences upon their return with the entire academic community and the beef cattle farming community in your region.

Prior to students travelling to Australia, they will undergo one week of pre-departure training in Tasikmalaya (PT. Lintas Nusa) on 3 – 6 August. From 12 -13 August students will travel to Australia to commence their Australian training and cattle station placements. The NTCA will cover all costs associated with travel, accommodation, and meals during the students' time in Australia as well as return international flights from Denpasar. Students will be required to arrange their own travel insurance and will be responsible for their own travel to and from Denpasar.

A detailed itinerary of pre departure training will be provided to successful applicants, including information on what to bring to Australia.
